

Ski In Ski Out Options- Blackjack



To walk to Alta Lifts from Blackjack

Note: This is for the hearty guest who is ready for potential experiences post holing and who is not afraid to perspire a bit before hitting the slopes.

You may want to consider taking The Alta Resort Shuttle. Call 801.301.0122 for a pickup.

- Walk out the Blackjack front door (as long as we are not interlodged)
- Head down our driveway and east,(to the right) through the Blackjack parking lot
- Pass a stucco house and a grey house on your right and the back of the Ben Hamme House on your left.
- Continue in this direction up the path, head up a slight incline
- Come down a slight incline to the Powder Ridge complex (you will see a garbage shed and big green condominium buildings)
- Continue to head east through Powder Ridge.
- At the Wildcat Chalet step onto the snowcat trail
- Continue to head east to the Collins/Wildcat base

To ski to Blackjack from Alta ski area:

Note: This is a route for **BLACK DIAMOND** skiers only. Know that you are venturing into a remote area that is not frequented by ski patrol or other skiers Expect unmarked obstacles. **Take this route at your own risk.**

From the Wildcat Chair:

- Dismount the chair and head to the right
- Follow trails into the Westward Ho area
- Stay high in Westward Ho and ski all the way to the west until you come to the rope line
- Follow the ropeline down the slope
- Cut skier's right as soon as the ropeline ends
- Traverse West **BE AWARE OF UNMARKED OBSTICLES AND CHALLENGING TERRAIN**
- Come to the back of the Blackjack building.
- Ski down!
- Have fun! Be careful!



To ski to Snowbird Center from Blackjack

Note: This requires an intermediate level of skiing.

- Walk out the Blackjack front door (as long as we are not interlodged)
- Head down our driveway and west (to the left)
- Pass 3 large houses on your left and Sugarplum Village to the right
- Continue in this direction to the end of the road towards The View Condominiums (large triangle shaped buildings with lots of windows)
- Pass The View onto the snowpack.
- You are on Snowbird's Who Dunnit trail.
- Look around, you will want to end up in this exact spot when you ski home.
- Ski down towards the road
- Follow trails down the hill
- Pass The Cliff Lodge (giant resort like building) on your right
- Continue to the Snowbird Center (on your right just after the base of the Peruvian chair)

To ski to Blackjack from Snowbird resort:

Note: This requires an intermediate level of skiing. Although there are Black Diamond routes to this destination, you will never need to travel on any trail that requires more than an intermediate level of skiing. These routes can sometimes be closed due to conditions. Check at Snowbird Center for closures.

- Take the Tram or the Peruvian chair
- Follow Chips Run (skier's right) to Who Dunnit?Rothman's Way intersection
- Stay on Who Dunnit
- Stop midway on Who Dunnit, when the trail hooks right and becomes steeper you will see 2 large houses and The View Condominium (large triangle shaped buildings with lots of windows)
- Head towards The View, do not ski down Who Dunnit
- Get onto the road/parking lot at The View. Head east (straight ahead)
- Pass Sugarplum Village on your left and 3 large houses on your right
- Arrive at Blackjack's driveway.
- Have fun! Be careful!
